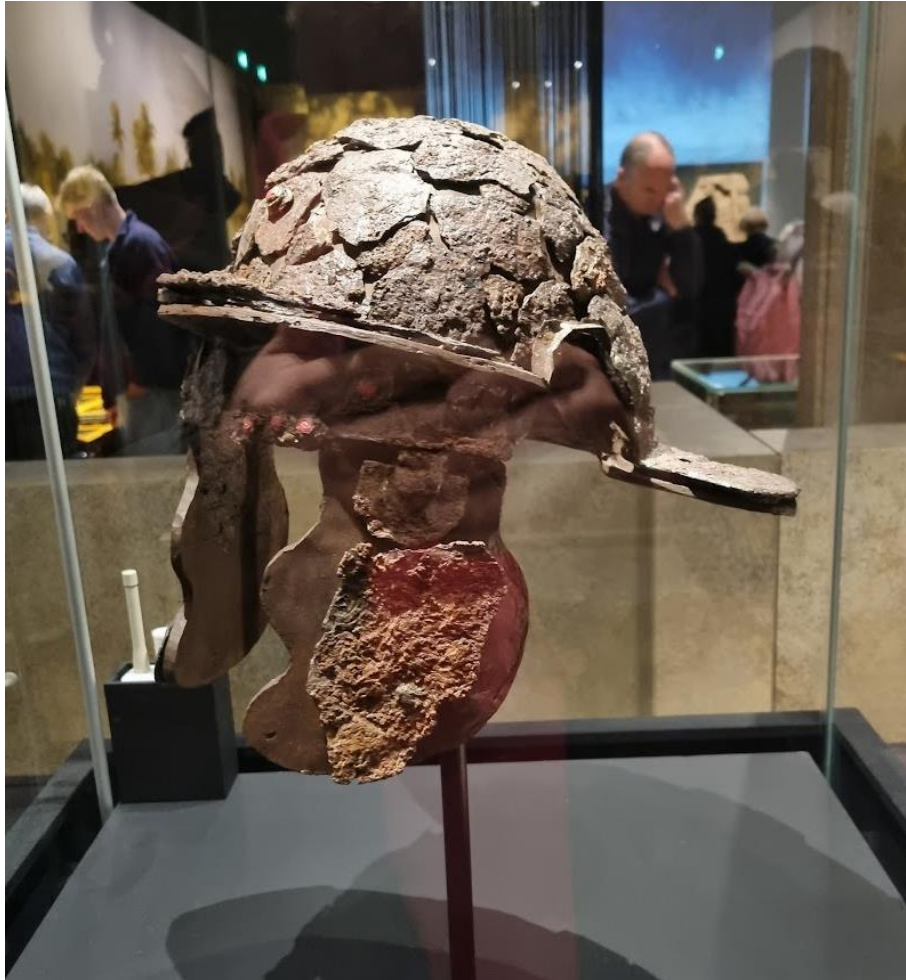

ROMAN SOLDIER'S HELMET



NAME:	Galea
DESCRIPTION:	This is a Roman soldier's helmet. It was made of bronze or steel and covered most of the soldier's head. This example is made from many parts of other helmets that archaeologists have found, from a place called Colchester in England. It dates from around 61 AD.
QUESTIONS:	1) Where was this helmet found? 2) How much of the soldier's head did it cover?
